

EGCC-EA Executive Committee held an emergency ZOOM meeting on Thursday, March 12

The following members were present: Gina Augustine, Adam Atkins, Ryan Fritch, Cathy Sistilli, Lori Parry, Shirley Fisher-Ciancetta, and Jonathan Knapp (LRC).

Meeting was called to order at 10:08 AM

Gina began by sharing what she and Adam learned yesterday (3/11/2020) at the EGCC Task Force (developed to respond to COVID-19):

1. EGCC is committed to keeping faculty, staff, and students safe
2. 12% of the college's courses are not using an online component- 716 students affected
3. There is a percentage of students who are taking online classes but using the computers on campus
4. Options offered for these students are:
 - Hybrid classes will be offered: 1 day per week
 - Labs open on campus
 - Cleaning and sanitizing daily
 - Any contact at school must be at least social distance (6 feet)
 - Promoting constant handwashing
5. Weekly and biweekly meetings with administration are planned
6. All Ohio public schools (public, private, and charter) are closed for at least the next 3 weeks
7. Campus-based classes have been canceled Monday 3/16 and Tuesday 3/17
8. Faculty should move as many classes as possible to online
9. Faculty should have access to Zoom accounts to teach their online classes
10. According to the CBA, staff has input in scheduling in the event scheduling is changed or reduced
11. Police academy and workforce will continue for the present
12. Students and Staff at the health clinical sites will follow protocols at those facilities
13. Employees might be asked screening questions such as recent travel, attending large gatherings, etc.

Gina also clarified:

14. Response is expected next Thursday on Step I of Grievance II for Tracey Anderson
15. Jonathan will be meeting next week with HR to resolve a salary issue for a faculty member
16. Update provided on support staff member whose job was recently moved from grant-funded to regular employee
17. The agenda for the 3/18 Labor Management Mtg. currently focuses on the status of the remaining 5 grievances—
 - Insurance committee
 - IT committee
 - Bargaining unit positions
 - Class size
 - Workload notification
18. A survey will be developed to help focus Monday's discussion with college administration.
